The Institute of Diplomacy and Foreign Relations (IDFR) was privileged to co-host a Special Talk by Sir Mark Moody-Stuart, a notable name in the corporate world, with the Institute of Malaysian and International Studies (IKMAS), Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia (UKM). Titled “Responsible Leadership in the Face of Energy Challenge”, the talk was held on Friday, 25 November 2022 from 9:00 am to 11:30 am at the IDFR Auditorium, Jalan Wisma Putra, Kuala Lumpur. The event was attended physically and virtually by officials from various government ministries & agencies, Malaysian Missions abroad, foreign embassies, corporate organisations, Chambers of Commerce, as well as members of academia from universities and think tanks.

Having over 20 years of experience in the corporate sector, Sir Mark Moody-Stuart has not only led several top corporations in the world, but also served global leadership roles as a member of the UN Secretary General's Advisory Council for the Global Compact, followed by his appointment as Vice Chairman of the UN Global Compact Board (2006 to 2018) and Chairman of the Global Compact Foundation (2006-2022).

In his talk, Sir Mark Moody-Stuart shared his knowledge and lessons learnt on how best corporate leaders, state and non-state actors could work closely and constructively together in addressing challenges in regard to corporate sustainability, business ethics, and responsible leadership especially in the energy sector. The talk was then followed by a robust session with questions from both the audience in the auditorium as well as online.

The engaging session highlights the significant role of corporate leaders and their commitment in undertaking responsibilities to address the global challenges which continue to evolve into more complex forms and highly demand urgent responses.
