Economic Diplomacy Series (3/2015): Regional Integration Towards A People Centric Community: Sharing the Experience of ASEAN and Latin America

The Economic Diplomacy Series (EDS), which started in 2013, is collaboration between the Institute of Diplomacy and Foreign Relations (IDFR), World Trade Institute, University of Bern, Switzerland and Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia (UKM).
