Institute of Diplomacy and Foreign Relations

The Institute of Diplomacy and Foreign Relations (IDFR) is the training centre of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Malaysia. It provides training for Malaysian government officials and foreign diplomats in key areas such as politics, economic diplomacy, leadership, negotiation, public diplomacy, languages, cultural diplomacy, and other core diplomatic skills. These programmes are delivered through four dedicated learning centres.

Among IDFR's flagship programmes include:

- The Diploma in Diplomacy (DiD), a six-month intensive course for junior Malaysian diplomats in preparation for their first posting to Malaysian diplomatic missions. The course modules include bilateral and multilateral aspects of international relations, ASEAN, protocol, negotiations, public diplomacy, foreign languages, administration and finance;
- Diplomatic training courses are offered to international participants under the ambit of the Malaysian Technical Cooperation Programme (MTCP) in areas of diplomacy, strategic analysis and crisis management; and
- Sistem Pentadbiran Kerajaan Malaysia (SPKM): Pre-Posting Orientation Course for Home-Based Staff and Spouses for officers and staff from other Ministries and government Agencies at all levels. The course aims to equip them with relevant skills, tools and know-how when serving at Malaysian diplomatic missions abroad.

In addition to training, IDFR organises lecture series featuring prominent local and international leaders and experts. The institute is also evolving from a function-based to a subject-based learning institution. While the core mission remains the training of diplomats, IDFR is expanding its role by developing Subject Matter Experts (SMEs) to further strengthen its research and consultancy capabilities.

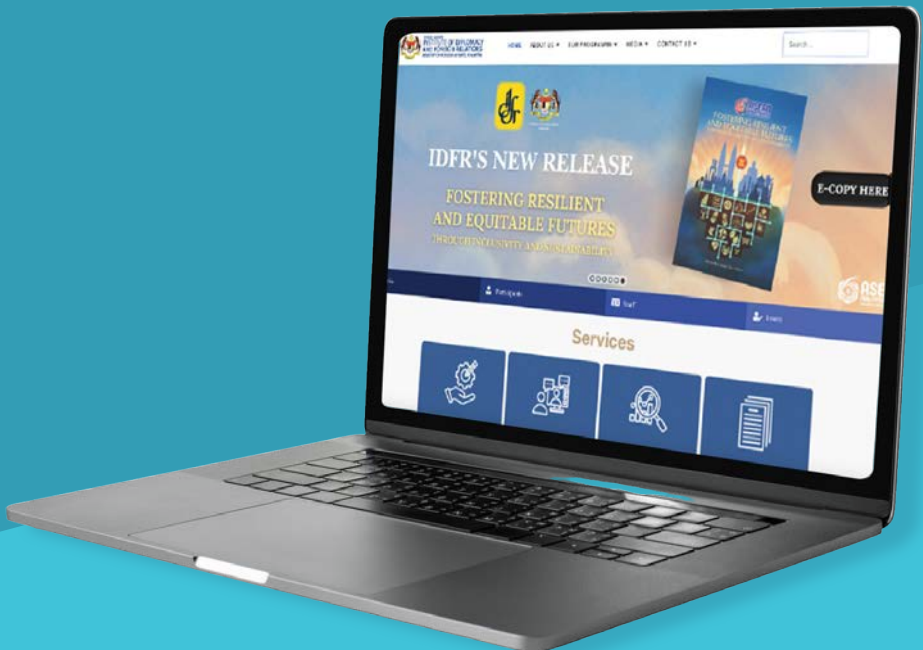

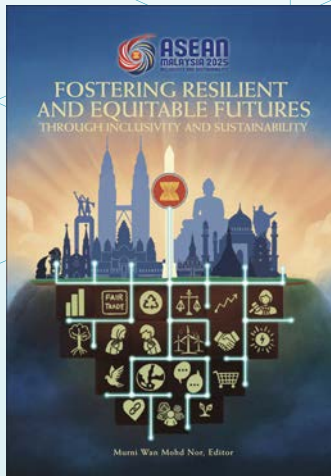

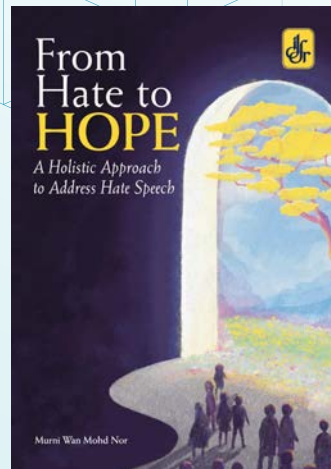
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
